**FOREST ROAD E17 – ROAD RESURFACING,
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

I am writing to let you know that road resurfacing work will take place on Forest Road between Pembar Avenue and Farnborough Avenue starting on Monday 10 March. With good progress the work should be completed by Thursday 13 March

Each day, in order to carry out the resurfacing in a safe and efficient manner, a temporary closure of Pembar Avenue, Farnborough Avenue and Pretoria Avenue between 9.00am and 5.00pm will be made at Forest Road. During these periods vehicle access for residents will be maintained via Tavistock Avenue and Ritchings Avenue.

To allow us to carry out the road works safely and on time, we are asking local residents and businesses to avoid parking in the area until the work has finished. Look out for signs and cones in the area to avoid parking in the wrong place - penalty notices will be issued to illegally parked vehicles and they may be removed. See reverse for details.

The work taking place on Forest Road aims to improve access for walking and cycling, road safety and the look and feel of the area. We sent you a letter last year explaining the results from the public consultation held in March 2016, and when the works would start. Please bear with us so we can make these improvements to the area as soon as possible. Our contractors will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum, and we will post regular construction updates online at www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/forest-road/construction.
