RE: Construction of a blended 'Copenhagen' crossing on Southwest Road E11

I am writing to let you know that work to construct a new blended 'Copenhagen' crossing Southwest Road, at its junction with Grove Green Road will start on **Monday 8 May**.

The blended 'Copenhagen' crossing design prioritises pedestrians at junctions, improves access for walking and cycling, and improves road safety.

We sent you a leaflet last year explaining the results from the public consultation held in January 2016, and when the works would start. You can find this leaflet online at: www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/leytonstone-town-centre/public-consultation-results.

Work will take place between 8am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday and will take two weeks to complete, weather permitting. To do the works quickly and safely, we need to temporarily close Southwest Road at its junction with Grove Green Road. During this time the one way in Southwest Road will be revoked to allow access from Avebury Road. Temporary traffic management will be in place during this time to minimise disruption to travel.

Please bear with us over the next few weeks so we can make these improvements to the area as soon as possible. Our contractors will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum and we will post regular construction updates online at www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/leytonstone-town-centre
