Dear Residents,

RE: Construction of raised junction table on The Avenue - update

I am writing to let you know that we will install a new raised junction table on The Avenue at its junction with Nightingale Avenue. This work will start on **Monday 24 April** and should take one week to complete, weather permitting. The work involves relaying of kerbs, some drainage works and resurfacing of the carriageway. These works are scheduled to take place between 8am and 5pm from Monday to Friday.

During the work, there will be some temporary road changes as follows:

- Nightingale Avenue will be closed at its junction with The Avenue.
- Parking will be suspended on The Avenue/ Nightingale Avenue junction - please look out for cones and advisory signs.
- Pedestrians will still be able to walk along the street as normal.
- On completion of kerb and drainage works, the carriageway will be resurfaced to form a raised junction table between 9.30am and 3.30pm under two-way temporary traffic lights.

These works are part of the ongoing improvement to Highams Park Town Centre, and aim to improve road safety and access for walking and cycling. We sent you a leaflet last year explaining the results from the public consultation held in June and July 2016, and when the work would start. Please bear with us during construction so we can make these improvements to the area as soon as possible.
