Dear Residents/ Businesses,

**RE: Overnight road resurfacing work on Chingford Lane**

I'm writing to let you know that the section of Chingford Lane between Elm Grove and Betoyn Avenue will be resurfaced from **Monday 10 April** and should take **one week** to complete, weather permitting. The resurfacing works will take place overnight between the hours of **8pm and 5am**, Monday to Friday.

During the work the following temporary road changes will be in place. Advance warning signs and diversion signs will be displayed in the area to let drivers know about these temporary changes.

- Chingford Lane will be closed to all vehicles between Elm Grove and Betoyn Avenue. There will be no vehicle access to this section of Chingford Lane and from the side roads, except for emergency vehicles.
- Parking will be suspended along Chingford Lane between Elm Grove and Betoyn Avenue and for the first 30 metres into the side streets (Lichfield Road, Montalt Road and The Avenue).
- Diversions for non-local traffic will be via Hatch Lane, New Road, Larkshall Road, Hale End Road, Forest Road, Woodford New Road and High Road Woodford Green.

To allow us to carry out the work safely and on time, please avoid parking in the area. **Temporary parking restrictions will be in force from 7pm to 5am, Monday to Friday.** Look out for signs and cones to avoid parking in the wrong place as illegally parked vehicles will get penalty notices and may be removed - see reverse for details. Parking will be available on the side roads, so please use this space instead.

Please bear with us while we make these improvements to the area. There will be some noise from the machinery used during the work, but where possible we will complete the noisiest work before 11pm to minimise the disturbance.
