Dear Residents / Businesses,

RE: Overnight road resurfacing work on Friday Hill and Hatch Lane

I'm writing to let you know that Hatch Lane and Friday Hill at its junction with Friday Hill roundabout will be resurfaced from **Monday 15 May** and should take **five nights** to complete, weather permitting. The resurfacing work will take place overnight between the hours of **9pm and 5am**, Monday to Friday.

During the work the following temporary road changes will be in place. Advance warning signs and diversion signs will be displayed in the area to let drivers know about these temporary changes.

- Friday Hill will be closed to all vehicles between Chingdale Road and Friday Hill roundabout. There will be no vehicle access to this section of Friday Hill, except for emergency vehicles
- Parking will be suspended along Chingdale Road for the first 30 metres from Friday Hill
- Hatch Lane will be closed to all vehicles between Connington Crescent and Friday Hill roundabout. There will be no vehicle access to this section of Friday Hill, except for emergency vehicles
- While we close Friday Hill, Hatch Lane will be opened and when Hatch is closed Friday Hill will be opened
- Diversions will be in place via Hatch Lane, New Road, Larkshall Road, King's Road and Friday Hill.

To allow us to carry out the work safely and on time, please avoid parking in the area. **Temporary parking restrictions will be in place from 7pm to 5am, Monday to Friday.** Look out for signs and cones to avoid parking in the wrong place as illegally parked vehicles will get penalty notices and may be removed - see reverse for details. Parking will be available on the side roads, so please use this space instead.

Please bear with us while we make these improvements to the area. There will be some noise from the machinery used during the work, but where possible we will complete the noisiest work before 11pm to minimise the disturbance. Our contractors will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum and we will post regular construction updates online at www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/chingford-town-centre/construction-updates
